THE SPELLBINDING EFFECT OF CHARM CITY


When it comes to conventions in Baltimore, there's one big name that everyone remembers...and left in 2016, taking a chunk of the city's identity with it.

We're not just aiming to create a convention—we're setting out to be the city's new flagship event while boosting both the local economy and Baltimore's reputation as a creative and hospitable hub.




Economic Growth

Connecting to Baltimore's Roots

As the city of Edgar Allan Poe, Baltimore is renowned for its Gothic and horror heritage. There's a natural synergy between the city's dark roots and the strong interest in both anime and Gothic subcultures among Baltimore natives.

RESURRECTING OUR NERDY ROOTS

Anime and cosplay are key ingredients for any Japanese culture niche event. They have also been an increasingly growing hobby over the last 10 years.

The global anime market is projected to surpass \$48 billion by 2030 and U.S. fans have shown increasing demand for new conventions and pop culture events.

Baltimore, with its young, diverse, and nerdy entrepreneurial population is primed for the introduction of more experimental and novel events that cater to this shared interest.

TIMING, THEMATIC **ADVANTAGE & LOCATION**

KurayamiCon would be ideally be held during late September-**October**; capitalizing on the Halloween season when interest in Horror, dark arts, and the eerie oddities is at it's high.

This timing also avoids clashes with major regional conventions.

A convention with a Japanese Horror and Gothic theme would offer something fresh to the convention circuit, making Baltimore a prime destination for fans, hobbyist, and peaked interests.

OUR VENUE

While we're all about dreaming big, we also know the importance of staying grounded in reality.

For our inaugural event, we're planning to host KurayamiCon at The Maritime Conference Center, just 15-20 minutes from Downtown Baltimore. This will allow us to test the event and gauge interest before moving Downtown if we feel that the next step for growth.

Here's why we believe this location is the perfect fit:

Meeting Spaces & Lodging

With a combined 55 event spaces, renovated state of the art theater, and 232 guest rooms on property, **The MCC** would be the ideal host all events and programming for expected attendees.

Food Options

While there are a number of local and affordable food options nearby, MCC offers breakfast, lunch, breakout snack options, and dinner buffets for guest staying on the property but also to attendees of the events being held.



Travel Accessibility

For our out-of-town guests, the location is just a quick 5-minute ride from **Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood** Marshall Airport. And for local attendees, easy access to the light rail, MARC train, and multiple bus lines. MCC also offers a shuttle service at zero cost to event attendees.

Cost Effective

Mid to Large-scale events come with financial challenges. Rather than the expected venue for our inaugural event, the Baltimore Convention **Center**—we're able to keep costs manageable with this approach first with sought after amenities already included in ticket prices.

Horror Film Theater Dedicated screening room to showcase a curated selection of Asian horror films, known for their psychological intensity and supernatural elements, alongside Western films with similar dark, thematic undertones

Let's Play Stage



Stage for the presenting gamer(s) to showcase their skills in real-time, engaging with a live audience. This interactive stage will not only feature solo gameplay but also host exciting competitions, tournaments, and collaborative gaming sessions where the audience can join in on the action



OC (Original Character) Pageant

Along side the traditional Hall Costume Contest, this pageant would cater to cosplayers and artists to challenge not only their skills of costuming, but also bringing original characters to life for a panel of judges. Creators would be given a prompt to work with.



A curated concert of DMV and visiting talent (4-5 acts) in metal, rock, alternative rock, industrial, punk, dark pop, synth-pop, nerdcore/filk, rap, or any other genre. Concert headlined by one of the listed acts

Goth Prom & 19th Century Formal Ball

Two different themed experiences: One celebrating the elegance and history of Baltimore through elaborate costumes and refined ambiance; the other being a traditional prom vibe with a dark and stylish makeover

EXAMPLES*:

"Tales from the Underworld"

A deep dive into the portrayal of witches and the occult across anime and horror genres, exploring how these depictions reflect societal fears and fascinations.

"Summoning Your Inner Villain"

A panel for cosplayers focused on embodying sinister characters from anime, horror films, and Gothic fiction, with tips and techniques on costume design and performance.

"Horror Soundscapes: The Power of Music"

Exploring the role of eerie soundtracks and atmospheric music with examples from classic and modern works that send chills down the spine

"From Poe to Ito: Gothic Literature In Asian Horror"

A panel comparing Western Gothic literature, like that of Edgar Allan Poe, with the unique horror storytelling styles found in Japanese and Korean horror media

"Nightmare in Ink – An Illustration Workshop"

A hands-on workshop where attendees learn to create dark, macabre art inspired by horror, gothic, and Asian folklore under the guidance of professional horror illustrators.

An acting workshop that teaches participants how to embody fear, suspense, and terror to convincingly play the iconic victim or villain in horror scenes.

A photography workshop focused on capturing eerie, cinematic scenes using lighting techniques

"Scary Stories for Kids"

A storytelling session featuring spooky but not-too-scary stories, narrated by professional storytellers in a darkened but friendly atmosphere

"Kid-Friendly Anime Screenings"

Screenings of horror or fantasy-themed anime suitable for children, such as Spirited Away, Kiki's Delivery Service, Yokai Watch, and more

Kids can dress up in costumes and collect candy at different booths or from cosplayers as they walk through a haunted but playful trail around the convention

A fun, spooky-themed dance party with ageappropriate music, glow-in-the-dark decorations, and costumed characters interacting with the children

"Pumpkin Decorating Contest"

A non-carving pumpkin decorating contest where kids can paint or accessorize small pumpkins with spooky designs, with prizes for creativity


As much as there is a undying passion for The Arts in Baltimore, there is a lack of support and resources that allow freedom to create for those without privilege.


